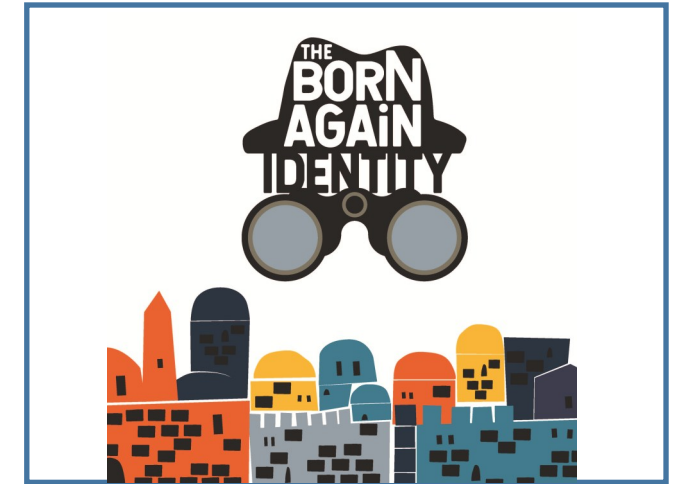
COMING TRAINING FOR NC BAPTIST DISASTER RELIEF
