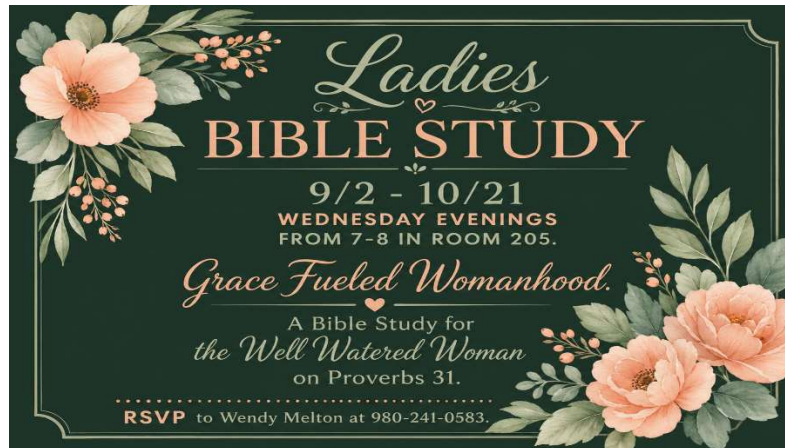

CHEST OF JOASH SUNDAY AUGUST 30TH – Please be much in prayer about what the Lord would have you give to our upcoming Chest of Joash Building Fund Offering later this month. In addition to our regular fifth Sunday Chest of Joash offerings, you are welcome to make contributions to our Building Fund (or General Fund) of stocks, bonds, mutual funds, etc. at any time during the year. IRA retirement distributions may also be made at any time during the year. A stock donor is entitled to a charitable deduction for the full (appreciated) value of the stock and pays no capital gains tax, and the transfer is receipted when received. An IRA donor who is at least 70 1/2 may transfer up to \$100,000.00 to Highland Park annually. While there is no charitable deduction, the amount does not count as regular income and is not taxed, and therefore it functions the same as a deduction and satisfies the required minimum distribution of the IRA. Contributions may be made anonymously, if you so desire.
