



Family Life Center General Use Policy for Gymnasium and Walking Track

Perspective:

We expect the Family Life Center to be a uniquely Christian environment. The rules, policies, and procedures are planned to be Christ honoring.

Priority of use

The priority used for determining the use of the building shall be:

1. Church-wide Events
2. HPBC Organizations
3. Scheduled recreation programs and classes
4. Associational or Church Leagues in which we participate.
5. Church Members

Participation:

All members of HPBC are eligible to utilize the FLC. Each family will be given a code to access the front door of the FLC. The minimum age for use of the FLC without an adult is 16.

Policies:

- A. The “General Use” hours of operation will be Monday-Friday from 5 am until 10 pm and Sunday 1 pm until 10 pm.
- B. The “general use area” consists of the gymnasium and walking track only. Use of the classrooms, kitchen, sound room and stage area are not permitted without prior permission.
- C. Members may invite a maximum of four (4) guests to participate in activities at the FLC. However, the member is responsible for his or her guest(s) while in the FLC, as well as the proper use of the facility and equipment.
- D. All groups using FLC will be responsible for their own program and for providing adequate adult supervision. It is recommended that there be one adult for each 10 persons under 18 years of age.
- E. No tobacco or alcohol use of any kind will be allowed in the FLC.
- F. No food, drinks (other than water) or chewing gum will be allowed in the gym except for when church related activities such as banquets or receptions have been scheduled.

- G. No loitering outside or in the parking lots will be permitted.
- H. In the interest of influencing others for Christ, the speech, dress, and conduct of all members, guests, and visitors will be in accordance with the highest Christian standards. The following is a dress code for the FLC;
 - 1. Gym clothes may be worn in the gym during competitive activities.
 - 2. Shirts must be worn at all times.
 - 3. No short shorts, or apparel with alcohol, racial, sexual innuendo, or foul language will be allowed.
- I. No skates, skateboards will be allowed in FLC.
- J. The Volleyball net is to remain in place unless approval is given to take it down.
- K. Please turn off all lights if you are the last to leave.
